- 6. Comply with relevant QHSE legislation, regulations and standards in addition to specific local client regulations.
- 7. Carry out our operations following the PDCA method throughout all layers of the organization, in alignment with Core Value Continuous Improvement.
- 8. Include QHSE in employee evaluations, appraisals and rewards.
- 9. Ensure managers, supervisors, and team leaders lead by example in all QHSE matters.
- 10. Involve and engage our employees in QHSE matters effectively, transparently and with integrity (Core Value), thus stimulating two-way participatory interactions and ideas for improvement from all layers of the company.
- 11. Conduct and report incident investigations according to standard and when required local procedures, with the identification and implementation of preventative measures as main purpose.
- 12. Conduct periodic audits of, and update, all QHSE requirements.
